

FIRST AID - REGULATED COMBINED - Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid & Emergency First Aid at Work



This **extended** one-day course provides learners with an understanding of the key first aid injuries that could occur in work to adults, children and babies.

The training course partly fulfils the 12 hours of paediatric first aid training required by Ofsted/ESTYN and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) and allows someone to support a Paediatric First Aider.



INTENDED AUDIENCE

SYLLABUS

The course is made up of practical and theoretical sessions which include a range of topics focused on adults, children and infants including:

- ➔ Understanding the role and responsibilities of an emergency first aider
- ➔ Being able to safely assess an emergency situation
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and not breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone suffering a seizure
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone who is choking
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid to someone with external bleeding
- ➔ Knowing how to provide first aid to someone who is suffering from shock
- ➔ Know how to provide first aid to someone with bites, stings and minor injuries

ASSESSMENT

As a regulated qualification there are assessments to ensure the candidates have reached the required standard. There is a multi-choice paper and 6 practical assessments which are built into the observations of the day.

CERTIFICATION

Successful candidates will be issued with an Ofqual regulated Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid and Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work by the awarding body Quasafe. Both qualifications should be renewed in 3 years.

CANDIDATE NEEDS

This course is open to all. If there are any learning or physical needs, these should be notified in advance of the course to see what reasonable adjustments can be made in liaison with the awarding body.

LOCATION
