

# FIRST AID - REGULATED

## Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work & Forestry First Aid + F



This course is ideal for individuals working in the outdoors, providing Emergency First Aid skills as well environment-specific skills. The course provides the skills to keep someone alive until the ambulance arrives including airway management and cardiopulmonary resuscitation. In addition, the courses looks at the effects of temperature, catastrophic bleeds and Lyme disease.

This course meets the Health and Safety Executive's requirements for one or more emergency first aiders in the workplace and meets the requirement of Forestry Commissions' policy.

This course is suitable for individuals appointed as emergency first aiders in the workplace.

### SYLLABUS

The course is made up of practical and theoretical sessions on topics including:

- ➔ Being able to safely assess an emergency situation
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and not breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone suffering a seizure
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone who is choking
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid to someone with external bleeding
- ➔ Knowing how to provide first aid to someone who is suffering from shock
- ➔ Know how to provide first aid to someone with minor burns or scalds
- ➔ Know how to manage casualty in extremes of temperature
- ➔ Being able to manage a catastrophic bleed
- ➔ Know how to manage a casualty with Lyme disease or an adder snake bite
