

# FIRST AID - REGULATED

## Level 3 Award in Emergency

### Paediatric First Aid

This one-day course provides learners with an understanding of the key first aid injuries a parent or guardian of a child may come across.

The training course partly fulfils the 12 hours of paediatric first aid training required by Ofsted/ESTYN and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). This course is suitable where you will be supporting someone holding the full Paediatric First Aid qualification.

#### INTENDED AUDIENCE

This course is suitable for individuals not working one to one with a child, including:

- ➔ Primary School Teachers
- ➔ Child minders
- ➔ Nursery nurses
- ➔ Parents

#### SYLLABUS

The course is made up of practical and theoretical sessions which include a range of topics focused on infants and children including:

- ➔ Understanding the role and responsibilities of a paediatric first aider
- ➔ Being able to safely assess an emergency situation
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone unresponsive and not breathing
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone suffering a seizure
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid for someone who is choking
- ➔ Being able to provide first aid to someone with external bleeding
- ➔ Knowing how to provide first aid to someone who is suffering from shock
- ➔ Know how to provide first aid to someone with bites, stings and minor injuries

#### ASSESSMENT

As a regulated qualification there are assessments to ensure the candidates have reached the required standard. There is a multi-choice paper and 5 practical assessments which are built into the observations of the day.

#### CERTIFICATION

Successful candidates will be issued with an Ofqual regulated Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid by the awarding body Quasafe.

#### LOCATION

We deliver the training course at a venue of your choosing. This can be a training room at your offices or a hired venue to give candidates space away from work. The location will require:

- ✓ Room big enough for up to 12 people to sit in a horse shoe
- ✓ Tables for group work and assessments
