Candidates must be in possession of an existing first aid at work certificate.

PREREQUISITES

Candidates must have previously completed a First Aid at Work course and be able to show the certificate. The course must be started within a month of the certificate expiring. If the certificate has expired you are not recognised as a first aider at work.

ASSESSMENT

As a regulated qualification there are assessments to ensure the candidates have reached the required standard.

There are two multi-choice papers and 7 practical assessments which are built into the observations of the day.

LOCATION
